You are invited to attend a trip on **27th March 2010** to the **1001 Inventions Exhibition at the Science Museum**. Discover the *Muslim Heritage in Our World*, which traces the forgotten story of a thousand years of science from the Muslim World, from the 7th century onwards. Featuring a diverse range of exhibits, interactive displays and dramatisation, the exhibition shows how many modern inventions, spanning fields such as engineering, medicine and design, can trace their roots back to Muslim Civilisation.
